Connection Point Church Family,

I want to begin by telling you how thankful I am to be doing ministry with you and with your families. We serve a great God who consistently makes beauty from the ashes and who is on the throne in heaven.

No doubt these are crazy days (how many times have we said that in the last couple of months :) we are in, but at Connection Point Church we are committed to participating in the mission of Christ. While we know there are many families that will continue to engage online during this time, we have many that are returning to Connection Point Kids and Connection Point Youth on Sunday morning and Sunday evening.

In order to provide excellent care and protection for all of our volunteers kids and students during this season we are asking everyone follow the guidelines listed below. These guidelines will be in place for the foreseeable future.

1. The following series of questions will be asked of everyone before a temperature check is administered. If answered “yes” to any of these questions the individual will be asked to join us online.
 - Are you feeling sick?
 - Have you traveled outside of the U.S. in the past 14 days?
 - Are you currently under quarantine from your workplace or school?
 - Have you been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
2. Temperature checks will be administered to every individual wanting to participate in all of our ministry areas (kids, youth, and volunteers). These will take place before anyone is allowed to check-in. Once a temperature check has been completed, individuals will be allowed to check-in and receive their sticker. A check-in sticker means a temperature check has been completed.
3. Upon entering Brightside, Kids Cove, Big Backyard, and Third Place volunteers will be required to wear masks during the entire time of interaction with other individuals. Additionally, all kids in Brightside and youth in Third Place will be asked to wear masks, at all times.
4. During service in all of our kids and youth areas we are asking that everyone remain with their class groups. Our intention is for there to be as little mixing of individuals as possible. This will help us when tracking potential cases.
5. Everyone is encouraged to use sanitizer throughout the morning. All tables and surfaces will be wiped down with disinfectant after each class, in all areas. Toys in Kid's Cove and Big backyard will be set aside after use to thoroughly disinfect during the week.
